Johnathan Crosby, Sr.: MA

He was a Private who served with Capt Joseph Bradley Varnum's Company of Volunteers from Dracut MA, Col. Jonathan Reed's regiment. He enlisted 29 Sept 1777 and was discharged 7 Nov 1777; service 42 days, travel included, at Saratoga. Company was raised to reinforce the Northern Army. Johnathan Crosby Sr.'s sons all fought in the Revolutionary War with son Benjamin Crosby killed at the Battle of Bunker (Breeds) Hill.

Compatriot Edwin Crosby served his country with the 7131st Tactical Air Command based out of St. Louis MO. His foreign service included Toul Rosier AFB, France during the Berlin Wall Crisis during 1961-1962.
