

WILLIAM FROGG.

Signed petition of settlers (74 signers) of Greenbrier County, VA to Montgomery County Court in 1777. Frogg was a Private Express Rider in Capt. Christopher Roans Company of Artillery. 01 August 1776 Virginia Council ordered a Commission appointed WILLIAM CHRISTIAN, Colonel of a Battalion and to be Commander-in-Chief of all forces. It was decided to send two Battalions of troops upon this expedition know as the "Rear Guard of the Revolution" They went into the Cherokee country for the purpose of "severely chastising that cruel and perfidious Cherokee Nation, a British Allie." Served as Private in this action.
