### Adley Brown

Adley Brown served the Revolutionary War as a Private in Captain Evan Anderson's Company of the Chester County militia made up in West Whiteland and North Goshen Townships during the years 1780, 1781, and 1782; as a Private; Captain Joseph Johnson's Company of the town of Goshen for the first part of the year 1781; as a Private, Muster Roll for the Captain Israel Moore containing the 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> classes of the 4<sup>th</sup> battalion of the Chester County Militia (Vol. V, pp. 596, 602, 623, 629, 652, 684, 633 and 644, Pennsylvania Archives, Fifth Series)

He married Tamer Forrester, who was born 4/18/1754, so the time of his birth was probably between 1750 and 1753. Tamer Brown survived her husband and died the latter part of 1831.
